

Background: The late Gordon Lindsay and his wife, Freda, spearheaded *The Voice of Healing* ministry beginning in 1948. They founded Christ For The Nations Institute in 1970 to train and equip "World Changers". Gordon envisioned thousands of Spirit-filled believers going forth to do exploits for God around the world. After Gordon's passing in 1973, Mrs. Freda Lindsay followed his vision and the ministry is flourishing.

Statement of Purpose: The Christ For The Nations 20/10 Ministry Scholarship has been established to assist churches in training and equipping people from their ministries. These students will return and serve in their home church after their term of training is completed at CFNI, fulfilling the vision of CFNI.

Scholarship Value/Commitment:

20/10 Ministry Scholarship –

Covered—20 percent minimum of tuition subsidized by the sponsor ministry, such as a home church.

Covered—10 percent of tuition subsidized by Christ For The Nations.

Not Covered—Housing and associated costs, meals, books, extra-cost electives, SOWTA technical arts fee, deferment fees, registration fee, student activity fee and other fees not listed as *covered* above.

Commitment—awarded student commits to serve at the sponsor ministry for an agreed upon period (not to exceed 12 months) immediately following completion of training at CFNI.

Basis for Selection: Application for scholarship will be reviewed by the CFNI admissions department after acceptance to Christ For The Nations Institute. To be eligible for the scholarship, applicant must be a United States citizen or legal permanent resident and enrolled as an on-campus student. A committee will review the submitted applications. Acceptance is based on the application, pastor's and personal recommendations and available scholarship funds.

Length of Scholarship: The 20/10 Ministry Scholarship is awarded consists of one spring and one fall semester. Scholarships are awarded annually and may run concurrently for a maximum of three years.

Deadlines for Application: For the fall semester, the deadline is July 1st. For students enrolling for a spring semester, the deadline is November 1st. Return scholarship applications to the director of admissions at CFNI.
